

Rooster Tails Fishing Club Annual Jackpot Fishing Contest 2018 RULES:

Rooster Tail Members in good standing may enter the Club's Annual Jackpot Fishing Contest by paying an entry fee of \$10.00 to the Contest Chairman or Club Treasurer. The payment must be made 2 weeks in advance of your entry and any time between the starting and ending contest dates.

Rooster Tail Member Grand Slam Fishing Challenge 2018 RULES:

January 1 - November 30. Striped Bass; Kokanee; Large Mouth Bass; Salmon (river or ocean) This is a fishing contest for Rooster Tail members in good standing with paid annual dues and a signed liability form on file with the club. The Grand Slam Fishing Challenge (GSFC) was created for club members with a higher degree of fishing skills, to focus on

Annual Fishing Contests' Rules

Annual Jackpot Contest Rules—continued

No fish-entry will be accepted without a two week prior entry fee. The contest runs from January 1 through November 30 and only fish caught within this term qualify for the contest. Contest cash prizes and recognition certificates will be awarded at the Rooster Tails Annual Member's Banquet in January of the following year. Contest entrants that do not have a winning Jackpot Contest fish will have a chance (blind bogey) to win a proportionate cash prize based on a random drawing at the banquet. Potential blind bogey winners must be present at the banquet to receive their prize.

Only the following fish species legally caught as defined by DF&W regulations in California inland waters or the ocean waters immediately adjoining the California coast or Delta qualify for an entry as listed on the Jackpot board: \square Kokanee \square Landlocked Salmon \square River or Ocean King Salmon \square Striped Bass \square Rainbow Trout \square Brown Trout \square Steelhead \square Lake Trout (Mackinaw) \square Large Mouth Bass \square Small Mouth Bass \square Catfish \square Shad \square Crappie \square Sturgeon.

Only the total length of the fish measured on a straight-line from the tip of the nose to the end of the longest lobe of the tail (except Sturgeon to be measured from the nose to the 'V' in the fork of the tail) is to be documented on a contest entry form. Ties for the same length fish species will split that share of the total cash for that species. Fish weight is only for informational purposes and no bearing on entry parameters. Contest entrants are encouraged to release all fish not intended to be kept for table-fare. Catch and release entries are to be confirmed with a photo and witnessed by a current member of the Rooster Tails Fishing Club. All final determination of Jackpot contest winners and the resolution of any conflicts is at the discretion of the Rooster Tail's Board of Directors.

The catch entry form along with a photo must be submitted to the Contest Chairman by hand, mail, or email within 30 days of the catch-date. Entry forms are available from the club web site under the club events tab and clicking on Jackpot contest. Verbal entry information will not qualify as an official Jackpot entry. The leading entries will be posted on the Jackpot Contest Board displayed at every third Friday breakfast meeting.

specific fish species, and to compete to win one large single cash prize and Trophy. This club contest is based on contest-ants catching and submitting the lengths of only four (4) predetermined fish species caught in California or adjoining California ocean waters. During the time frame, contestants submit successive entries of increased lengths over their prior catch in any of the four pre-determined fish species (LISTED ABOVE). The final combined total length of the four species by the end of the contest date determines a single winner of the GSFC, however the winning length contestant must have caught at least one of all four species. The standing of each contestant's length tally will be displayed on the GSFC score board at each breakfast meeting and published in the club's monthly newsletter.

- 1. The GSFC officially starts at safe light on the morning of January 1 and ends at sunset November 30. No fish entry will be accepted prior to the two week minimum entry lead-time.

 2. A contestant may enter the GSFC any time during the contest period, but no later than two weeks before the contest ends by submitting a \$50.00 entry fee dated check, no cash. Hence, the GSFC will be limited to 20 paid contestants, excluding fishing guides, by November 15 with an anticipated single cash prize and GSFC trophy presented at the Rooster Tail Annual Holiday Brunch.
- 3. All contest fish submitted as entries must be legally caught as per current DF&W regulations. Contest fish must be solely and independently hooked, fought, and landed without aid in any manner of another person. Netting assistance is allowed by a fishing partner.
- 4. Should a contestant have the longest combined length tally, but not all four designated species, it would preclude him/her from being the winner. The next combined total length contestant that caught all four designated species would win the contest. Should no contestant catch all four species by November 30th, the GSFC cash purse would be rolled over to the following year and added to the New Years's contest entry fees.
- 5. Catch and release is allowed, but all GSFC entries must be submitted with a photo of the total fish displayed on a ruler/tape measuring devise clearly showing its length. Since the GSFC contest is based on length of combination of four fish, no entry will be accepted without a photo and a verifiable credible witness as determined by the RT Board of Directors (BOD). Contest photos may be taken with cell phone and other cameras and e-mailed as an attachment to ewingandas-socs@regan.com or info@roostertailsfishingclub.org.
- 6. Any discrepancies, disputes, and determination of a contest winner is per the majority decision of the Rooster Tails BOD. At the discretion of the BOD, may choose to add additional funds or other incentives to the GSFC. The BOD reserves the right to make changes, additions, or cancellation of the GSFC and notify participants in writing.

A note from Jim -

I would encourage all Rooster Tail members to join us to participate in our fishing contests for the following reasons:

- 1. The **Annual Jackpot Contest** is 'just for fun competition' and recognition by our club for having the good luck to catch a big fish! The rules are simple and require only \$10 bucks to enter the contest. Even a member that fishes only occasionally has a chance to win one or more of the 14 specie-categories. Any fishing trip you take may be the one with a **BIG FISH** that chooses you!
- 2. Due to multiple requests, the Rooster Tails Board of Directors created the **Annual Grand Slam Fishing Contest** for the more accomplished angler-member that fish frequently and wanted a more competitive contest with a big cash prize. Many of the rules are similar or the same between both contests, however the entry fee is \$50 dollars. It is important to read the rules for this contest with a potential pay-out of several hundred dollars.
- 3. Members can enter both the Jackpot and Grand Slam contests by paying the entry fees as per the written rules. Also be aware that one fish-entry can apply to both contests as long as two entry forms and photos are provided. **Photos of your catch and a completed entry form for both contests are required.** *Quality* photos provided from you will be submitted to *Western Outdoor News* and the *Fish Sniffer Magazine* for publication. Please be aware that to have a legal contest entry in either or both contests, you must have paid the **entry fee a minimum of (2) two-weeks** prior to submitting an entry. The Rooster Tails Board of Directors reserve the right to modify the contest rules with thirty days advance notification to participants.
